BIBS Prayer and Fasting Retreat 2016

Breaking Free of Strong Holds - 2 Cor. 10:4

Retreat 2016 was a life saving encounter; we came face to face with the raw power of the WORD of God: A privilege and honour we will never forget. It's true, the warfare raged as we fasted, prayed and diligently searched ourselves in preparation for the retreat, but looking back, it all makes perfect sense. God wrought a mighty deliverance through His WORD and equipped us for the fiaht.

Day 1: Loosing the Chains

God sent His WORD a verse at a time; and it was more than enough to do the job. As we read the first line of Isaiah chapter 58, "CRY Aloud, spare not... show my people their transgression" you could feel the chains of bondage rattling.

There was a surge of Holy Ghost power as every believer in the room began to draw out the meaning of the one verse. The Word, which is the Sword of the Spirit. accomplished that which God had purposed for that evening - real conviction.

Day 2: Shattering Strongholds

The WORD was so potent, that it continued to work in our hearts throughout the night and lit our early morning prayers.

The first session started with Matthew 6: 9-13; "Our father, which art in Heaven... give us this day our daily bread... thine is the Kingdom, and the POWER and the GLORY forever and ever. Amen". God purposed that we should know who He is: His sovereignty, His

sufficiency, His might, etc. It became abundantly clear that because of who He is, all spiritual strongholds are pregnable: GOD is awesome in POWER.

As the day progressed, without even realising it; we learned how to wield the spiritual weapons of Prayer; the WORD and Faith.

Weapon 1: We praved the Scriptures and prayed in the Spirit. Yes, we put aside our personal shopping list of needs and Wow! the Scripture was right: "We know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered..." Rom. 8: 26.

As we prayed, the chains around our hearts and minds began to break and shatter in pieces.

Weapon 2: During the teaching sessions that followed, we heard and saw how strongholds are formed in the mind and soon identified our own. God was amazing, He gave each person a Scripture and as they read it aloud, their stronghold came down.

Even today, we are still blown away by the immediate results we saw at the retreat: the strongholds of fear. anger, depression and many more. were shattered as we confessed God's Word with our mouths and believed it with all of our heart.

Day 3: Staying Free

We gave thanks from a grateful heart, our spirits were light; the praises flowed. Our loving Father sent His Word and we listened keenly: "...be not entangled again with the Yoke of Bondage", Gal. 5:1. Before you leave here you need to have a plan!

We left the retreat having SHATTERED our strongholds and armed with the spiritual weapons and knowing how to use them: -Confessing the WORD of God with our mouths; Believing it with the Heart; Praying in the Spirit; Praying the Scriptures; and committing the Words of God to memory.

Although the WAR continues we have fortified our minds with the WORD of God.

Here are but a few life changing testimonies...

"With my place at Retreat 2016 confirmed, I began to look forward to spending a weekend in the presence of God. A week or so before the retreat I received the email with the 'Recommended Preparation for Retreat 2016' and theme 'Breaking Free of Strongholds'.

Having read the letter I was determined to follow the instructions (which I did to the letter); I identified and acknowledged a couple of strongholds that pertained to me. However, by the end of the week's fast I acknowledged more strongholds than I originally started with (I felt quilty).

We arrived at the venue and were assigned our lodges and I was nominated as the leader for my lodge (I now feel guilt and shame). In the first session we studied Isaiah 58 and it was then that the Word really began to cut (another stronghold was realised - Fear).

Following the study we were encouraged to worship; at this point I felt dry; and as I looked around the room I felt as though I was the only one unconnected but I praised as best as I could; I couldn't wait to get back to the lodge.

As I led the morning prayer, I wasn't sure what to expect but I knew one thing, I did not want another experience like the night before. We began to pray and straight away we were on one accord; the anointing was so sweet and powerful that it was difficult to close.

The day just got better and better; the retreat team was awesome; it was like being on an accelerated fast-track program; and the spiritual strongholds began to be dismantled.

My breakthrough occurred after the teaching on 'praying in the spirit'; WOW, amazing! I was standing up praying when I was given a slap and ordered to pray in the spirit, after the spiritual encouragement I fell to knees and began to pray like I'd never prayed before.

I found myself in God's throne room, where all I could do was continually bow and cry Holy, Holy. I received a revelation regarding prayer and petitioning heaven; if we have faith and do not doubt or waver then we have spiritual access to heaven, where we can make our petition.

More blessings came during the session on the Stronghold of FEAR. I admitted a fear of not providing for my family; this fear was brought about due to my imminent redundancy.

During the exercise I received and confessed the scripture: "Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee" (Hebrews 6:14). This scripture has truly been a comfort, and I don't pray without it.

My God doesn't mess around, the following day He demonstrated Hebrews 6:14 to me. As we joined

for corporate prayer I felt God just catapulted me upwards and it's now for me to operate beyond my self-imposed limitations.

Retreat 2016 demonstrated for me, that there is a spirit behind every stronghold and that it emanated from within me. Every stronghold MUST be identified, located and shut down by me. I must defend my borders and keep safe my territories (this includes my family and brethren) because I realise that, I am AT WAR - 2 Cor. 10:5." A Brother

It was an awesome event; I did not want it to end. I praise the Lord and thank those who made the event possible." A Brother





God's WORD is POWERFUL

Often we preach, even teach that the Word of God is Powerful but we have yet to fully grasp its usefulness and its real value. We get excited about it; even rejoice about it but somehow in our day to day lives, when faced with crippling circumstances, we're so overwhelmed that we may not even think or know how to USE IT!

This BIBS Newsletter is on a mission to wake us up In the same way that a scud missile has a guidance to the power (explosiveness, energy) of the Word of God and to shift our mindset from just seeing the BIBLE as a leather-bound book of stories, to seeing GOD. If we could grab a hold of the fact that the WORD is GOD (Jn. 1:1) and see who He is: our Provider, our Deliverer, our Rock, and the Ruler of Everything; we would surely triumph over the enemy.

So, what makes God's Word powerful? When you look at the word 'powerful' in Scripture, it speaks of something that is active, energetic and dynamic; it implies that someone is 'at work' or doing something that is effective.



Can you imagine what would happen if we combined the POWER of the Holy Spirit, that resides in us (Acts: 1:8), with the POWER of God's WORD? Wow! We'd deal the enemy that fatal blow.

The Word of God is powerful because it SHALL do whatever God sends it to do; and within that Word (whether it's spoken or written) is the force, strategy, the capability and the wisdom; whatever is needed to get the job done. It SHALL accomplish! God said, "...My Word... shall not return unto me void... It shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it..." (Isa. 55:11).

system and is programmed to hit a specific target and does not go off course. God's Word is set and guaranteed to happen. It is sure! Moses, in Gen 1:3, puts it like this, "And God SAID let there be... and THERE WAS". God SPAKE and it was done, He COMMANDED and it stood fast; by His WORD was the world created (Ps. 33:9: Heb. 11:13).

I know what you're thinking; that's Creation; which is all well and good but how can the WORD of God help us on a day to day basis? Well, there are so many practical examples throughout the Scriptures where God speaks a WORD and none of it falls to

> the ground; every single promise He made came true.

> Just look at Abraham: he had no children. God not only SAID he would give him a son, but blessed him with so much more. Out of Abraham came the nation of Israel and the promised Messiah. In fact we today are the sons of Abraham by faith (Gen.15: 4-6; 22:18; Gal 3:16).

> When things got financially tight and there was no food for Elijah, the widow or her son (in fact she was about to cook the last meal and die); God not only provided for Elijah (as He said) but for the entire house. Not just one meal but a future supply. God's purpose had to be accomplished (1 Kin. 17:9).

> Our challenge today is to go beyond knowing how powerful the Word is, to experiencing its power in our lives. Can you

imagine what would happen if we combined the POWER of the Holy Spirit, that resides in us (Acts: 1:8), with the POWER of God's WORD? Wow! We'd deal the enemy that fatal blow.

So, we must take the Word of God from off the pages and deposit it into our thinking; for as a man thinketh in his heart, so is he (Pro. 23:7).

There's a common saying that, 'You are what you eat'. Well, it's true: whatever we feed our thoughts and preoccupy our minds with, will eventually form our thinking and the words we say. We NEED to use the Word of God to guard our MINDS. If we meditate on it (think on, mull it over) day and night we will prosper and have good success (Jos. 1:8; Ps. 1:2). Here's some food for thought! "...whatsoever things are true...whatsoever things are of good report...think on these things" (Phil 4:8).

Let's use the Word of God, not only to change the way we think but to change the way we speak! It's often what we say that defeats us; we talk defeat and are snared by the words of our mouth. How many times have we heard ourselves saying, "I can't do it"; "It's too much"; or "I'll never make it". Sound familiar?

Remember, death and life is in the power of the tongue; we bring our thoughts to life by uttering them. So, why not use the tongue to confess the WORD; speak those things that bring spiritual life, strength and peace.

Thinking and speaking the Word of God by itself will not release its power. We have got to believe His Word with all our heart. Yes! Mix the Word of God with faith for it to profit us. So why do we struggle and despite repeating the scripture we still feel the same? Well, we will only tend to trust someone if we know them and love them.

Could it be that we need to spend time knowing God? Then and only then, will we count Him as being worthy of our love; completely TRUST him and ABSOLUTELY rely upon the POWER of His WORD and USE IT.

God's Time Clock

"What time is it?" is probably the first question we ask in the morning and perhaps our last thought before we go to sleep. During the day we find ourselves constantly checking the time to make sure we are not late for an appointment, for work and dare I say it, that all important business meeting. We set our clocks to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) but have you ever stopped to ask yourself about God's time clock; where we are in terms of world events that must happen before the second coming of Christ and the End of Time?



As Christians, we tend to know that God has a set time when all things will come to an end; but are we clued up on the signs i.e. specific events concerning Israel, the World and the Church, that precedes the consummation of all things? Some of these events are unfolding before our very eyes, as the scene is being set for the antichrist.

Recently, a series of questions were put to Elder Mclean on the End Times and this is what he had to say about where we are in terms of Bible prophecy. Let's tell the TIME...

The rise of the 'One World Leader', the Antichrist

Looking at what's happening in the Middle East (Arab Countries from Egypt to the Persian Gulf, plus Israel and Iran) today, we can understand where we are in relation to Bible prophecy. As written in Ps. 83:4-7, we find now, more than ever, that the Arab/Islamic nations (descendants of Ishmael, Esau, Moab etc.) are contending with Israel; trying to totally annihilate

the nation. Israel is surrounded by Jordan, Syria, Lebanon and Kuwait to the North; Egypt to the South; Gaza, Libya, Afghanistan and Tunisia to the east. Iran, although not an Arab country, is Muslim and one of the players that Israel has to watch.

It is reported that the Iranian commander Mohammed Reza Nagdi said, "Israel should be wiped off the Map". Israeli Prime Minister, Mr. Netanyahu said: "The greatest threat to our security and future was and remains Iran's threat to arm itself with nuclear weapons..." For him, the deal being sought in Switzerland would mean that Iran could develop an 'atomic bomb' in less than a year. [Independent Online: 1 April 2015]

Today Israel is surrounded by 22 Arab/Muslim countries: all who wish to take the land; which they believe is their inheritance through Ishmael, and "wipe out Israel". They are slowly gathering together for the final battle of Armageddon that will take place in Israel, in the valley of Megiddo as prophesied in Scripture. Zec. 14:1-3; Rev. 19:18, tells us that God will gather all nations to fight against Jerusalem.

Over the last five years we have seen the overthrow of the rulers in the Middle East. The 'Arab Spring 2011', as it is commonly known, was a series of independent uprisings against oppressive governments, starting in Tunisia on December 2010 and spread rapidly across the Middle East. With the

Did You Know that the Syrian Migrant Crisis is fulfilling Prophecy?

According to the United Nations, the number of refugees and asylum seekers in the world today is equivalent to the population of Great Britain; 65.3 million people. People seeking refuge in foreign countries is not a new phenomenon; however the migrant crisis facing Europe is. More than a million migrants crossed into Europe in 2015. The numbers were so great that it left many of the EU countries struggling to cope with the influx and put a great strain on the economy.

No one would have ever imagined that this migrant crisis would divide Europe in the way that it has; the member states are fighting each other over inadequate border controls, who should be allowed asylum; if and where the refugees should eventually settle. Suddenly Europe has found itself at odds over this so-called 'humanitarian crisis'; "fault lines have opened up across Europe".

The division didn't just stop there; the migration crisis became the cause of many 'Brits' voting to exit the EU. When the results of the referendum came in: 51.9% (exit) to 48.1% (remain), it took the world by surprise; no one expected Britain would leave the EU. Whilst many celebrated, the stock markets went into a spin as the value of the pound and shares fell.

And if that wasn't bad enough our economy became weak at the knees, as the political parties fell in disarray at the announcement of David Cameron's resignation, which was shortly followed by ten Labour Cabinet ministers stepping down and declaring 'no confidence' in Jeremy Corbyn's leadership. This was unprecedented; never in the history of British politics have we seen such an upheaval.

Is the migration crisis a coincidence, or is it part of a greater plan?

In the book of Daniel 2.31-45, we see his vision of a great image. Each part of the image represents a successive kingdom: the ten toes of clay and iron are symbolic of the final kingdom that will be destroyed

by Christ at His return. Daniel speaks of the kingdom being "partly strong, and partly broken"; he said that: "they shall not cleave together even as iron is not mixed with clay". Europe, as hard as they have tried, still are unable to stabilise their union. Britain's sudden exit is just one in a chain of events that fulfils Daniel's prophecy.

In the book of the Revelation we also read about the prophecy of the great river Euphrates drying up in the end time, "that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared" (Rev. 16:12). Foreign Affairs (Aug 2012) reported, "The Tigris-Euphrates river basin, which feeds Syria and Iraq, is rapidly drying up. This vast area struggles to support at least ten million conflict-displaced people; and things could soon get worse"; the conflict is causing many to flee: the vast majority of whom are Syrians.

Amnesty International reports that Gulf countries and wealthy countries in the East have offered zero resettlement places to Syrian refugees and as a result, many Syrian refugees are looking towards Europe for help.

Time Magazine (July 2016), reported that before the Syrian migrant crisis the Muslim population of Europe was already growing exponentially. The Muslim population of the UK doubled between 1990 and 2010, and is set to double again by 2030. This trend is true of other EU countries. Some argue that Europe is set to become Islamic; it is just a question of to what extent.

So how does this affect Christianity?

The mission of Islamic fundamentalists is conquest (Jihad). It is not merely a war of bombs and bullets, but of beliefs. Their mission is to conquer the world for Allah; you must convert to Islam or be killed. They have declared war against Christianity.





To the Islamic extremists, Christianity is a false religion, it must be eradicated. Across Syria and Iraq ISIS torture Christians in the wickedest of ways: decapitating, crucifying, torturing men, women and even children. The rage against the Truth knows no bounds.

The radical Islamist believes he is continuing a 1,400-year old war against Christianity. Islamic fundamentalists seek revenge against the Roman Catholic crusades that took place during the Dark Ages. The war against Christianity is also a war against what the Fundamentalist believes is heresy. For Islam there is but one God, Allah; and it is inconceivable that there is any other. Fundamentalists associate Christianity with the belief in the trinity, which for them is blasphemy.

Any spirit that works against Christ is the spirit of antichrist. John warned that, "He is antichrist that denieth the father and the Son..." (1 Jn. 2:22-23). John also warned that the spirit of antichrist is already at work (1 Jn. 4:1, 4; 2 Thes. 2:7).

It's subtle but satan is the real evil fighting behind the scenes; he is behind the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria's (ISIS) relentless mission to convert Europe to Islam and annihilate Christianity. UK statistics show that Islam is on the increase whilst the number of Christians has fallen from 71% to 44% in just 15 years.

In conclusion

It is not just a Migrant Crisis; the hidden reality is that Islam is infiltrating our schools, workplaces and even our healthcare systems without us realising. Its influence is growing worldwide i.e. Islamists are resetting political agendas and changing the world economy. Satan cloaks himself in current events such as the migrant crisis; be not deceived, it is the spirit of antichrist at work and we are fast approaching the end of time.

death of the dictators and no leadership, we saw the rise of political factions: the Islamic brotherhood, ISIS, etc. Countries such as Syria and Libya were thrown into turmoil and civil unrest.

The sudden events of 2011 have paved the way for a one world leader, the antichrist, who will bring the much needed peace and deceive many, until the middle of the week. (Dan. 9:27; 2 Thess. 2:3-10).

The rise of a 'One World Religion'

Islam is the fastest growing religion in the world and is set to overtake Christianity by the end of the century, The Pew Research Centre has said, "the number of Muslims will grow more than twice as fast as the world's population..."

The ISIS mission to convert every nation to an "Islamic" state is rapidly becoming a reality, with fundamentalists positioned in the West and Syrian migrants (Muslims) scattered around the world. In addition to this. ISIS is reducing the number of Christians by killing thousands of them.

In conclusion

The signs are not just outside the Church but inside: there is a falling away. The love of many is waxing cold; men have become lovers of themselves more than lovers of God (2 Tim. 3:2). When we see these things we should look up, our redemption draweth nigh!
