



Bishop Martin Howard Simmonds

A man ahead of his time...

Bishop Simmonds' preparation to be the Principal of BIBS, unbeknown to him, begun deep in his heart many years before his divine appointment. As a young man of God he greatly hungered for biblical knowledge and spiritual growth; and in the years that followed he was blessed to glean from some of the great apostolic fathers and to train at several academic and theological institutes. As a master of theology his knowledge of the Word grew, but as a oneness believer so too did his desire for an Apostolic Bible School in the UK; then in 1994, his dream was realised.

In the autumn of 1994, Bethel United Church of Jesus Christ gave birth to its Apostolic Bible School. Bishop M. H. Simmonds was appointed by the Board of Bishops as the Principal of the School; and alongside faithful others he established and named it: Bethel Institute of Biblical Studies (BIBS).

"I thank God for the life and ministry of our first Principal of BIBS, Bishop Martin Howard Simmonds. He was a caring, knowledgeable, unpretentious and highly favoured man of God who was endowed with unreserved passion for God and His Holy Word.

The Days of Deception (Eph. 4:14)

During the early days of the Church, apostolic believers met with tremendous opposition: as Satan tried to destroy the Church from without by means of intense persecution. However, the more the Church was persecuted, the more it flourished. But the Word of God grew and multiplied (Acts 12.24).



Today however, satan is using strategies other than external persecution. It almost seems that during these last days, satan has said, "Alright, if I cannot destroy the Church from without, I will seek to do it from within. I will destroy the very foundations of the Church, which is the Word of God."

Believers who recognise the nature of this attack are asking the same question as King David in Psalm 11:3. "If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?"

As Jude pointed out, these men have crept in unawares. The Greek word rendered, 'crept in unawares', carries with it the idea of a thief slipping in through the backdoor. Jesus addressed the issue of apostasy, warning us to watch out for false prophets that come in sheep's clothing, but inwardly are ferocious wolves (Matt. 7:15).

Satan's secret agents have infiltrated our churches, our schools and organisations; seeking to destroy their spiritual foundations by casting doubt on the authority and infallibility of the Word of God.

apostates i.e. those who renounce the apostolic beliefs, godly principles and adulterate God's Word, use oneness terminology and orthodox vocabulary but with completely different meanings. Jude's letter has never been more relevant than in our generation and serves to warn today's Church of those things and people among us who come in sheep's clothing.

Recognising the Apostate...

In these days of deception, it is imperative to know and understand the ways of the apostate i.e. those who have departed from the Faith: giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils (1 Tim. 4:1).

You see, apostates may have received the Light of God, however they have abandoned the Truth for a lie. Jude expressed this truth saying, these men are blemishes in your love feasts eating with you without the slightest qualm [fear]; shepherds who feed only themselves; they are clouds without rain, blown along by the wind; autumn trees without fruit and uprooted; twice dead (Jud.12).

The apostate therefore knows the Truth but does not apply it; he accepts God's revelation as true but does not make a sincere commitment to it, or live in

accordance with the holy life that it demands. He is a synthetic [man-made, artificial, fake] Saint; insincere and full of deceitfulness. These wolves in sheep clothing 'lie in wait to deceive' (Eph. 4:14).

1. The Apostate's Seduction

Jude uses the phrase 'Ungodly Men' to describe men who lack reverential awe towards God: they do not fear God. These apostates look and act like us in order to deceive us; they are able to entice us to believe a lie because they came from amongst us, yet they were not of us (1 Jn. 2:19). They talk about God and use the right words but their hearts are far from Him.

WARNING: these 'Ungodly Men' may be gifted, courteous, gentle, kind and even generous in the eyes of others but in the eyes of God they are godless.

The Apostle Paul warned Timothy about these individuals in the ministry; who appear to be godly but renounce its sanctifying influence (2 Tim. 3:5); he told Timothy to 'turn away' from those who have a 'form of godliness' but deny its power.

2. The Apostate's Behaviour

The apostate changes the Grace of our God into lasciviousness i.e. use it as a licence for immorality (Jud. 4). These men assert that they can sin all they like and God will forgive them. They think that the more they sin, the greater God's grace toward them will be. They have no thought of its consequence or of divine judgement.

The word lasciviousness means 'absence of moral restraint'. The Greeks used the word 'Aselgeia', to describe a person who is so lost to decency, honour and shame, that he does not care who knows about his sin. He has no feelings of guilt or remorse.

Apostates assume that their privileges in the Apostolic Faith somehow puts them above the moral responsibility of the Word of God, that binds a true believer to lifestyle of godliness and purity.

The Apostle Paul explained that the Grace of God that bringeth salvation has appeared to all men. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions; and to exercise self- control, be upright and live godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope: the glorious appearing of our great God and Saviour, Jesus Christ (Tit. 2:11-13).

3. The Apostate Perverts Worship

The apostate's motive for worship is impure. They are filled with covetousness and are generally motivated by money, power, worldly gain and self-exaltation.

They introduce unholy methods e.g. when King David sought to bring the Ark home, instead of using God's prescribed method of carrying the ark, they used a new cart and incurred the displeasure of God. True worship does everything decently and in divine

4. The Apostate Perverts the **Doctrine of Christ**

According to the Apostle Peter. the Apostate secretly brings in damnable heresies that deny the Only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ. Many also follow their evil ways and because of them the Truth is rejected and evil spoken of (2 Pet. 2:1-3; Jude.4).

These false teachers have re-translated the Bible and also misinterpret the Scriptures i.e. give the wrong meaning to satisfy their evil desires. They handle the Word of God deceitfully and thereby make merchandise of God's people (2 Cor. 4:2).

Sadly but true, there are preachers today that say we do not need to be filled with the Holy Ghost, it is optional: in order to appease and/or retain large congregations. However, the Apostle Paul warned that the time would come when men would not endure sound doctrine but after their own lusts, shall heap to themselves teachers, having Itching ears; and will turn their ears away from the Truth and turn unto fables (2 Tim. 4:3-4).

Fight for the FAITH

The real problem that the Church faces in dealing with apostasy today, is the problem of apathy, which Webster's New World Dictionary defines as: 'lack of interest' or 'Indifference'. Churches are dying, not simply because apostates have crept in but because godly men and women have become apathetic and have done nothing to stop

In an apologetic sense, we must not only defend the faith by having a knowledge of the Truth but must take seriously the inescapable mandate to which the apostle Jude summoned us to, "Earnestly contend for the Faith which was once delivered unto the Saints": the Faith being the whole body of

Biblical doctrine that comprises the perfect totality of Truth. It is the teachings of Christ which he taught his twelve disciples and they in turn delivered it unto the Saints and to us today.

As custodians of this great Apostolic Faith, we have been entrusted with the Word of the Living God. That is why we cannot stand by idly and watch the Bible being ridiculed and torn apart by liberal theologians. We must take seriously this divine call to 'earnestly contend for the Faith'.

In these 'Days of Deception', knowing and fully understanding the doctrine of Jesus Christ (see pages 8 & 9) is the only way to DISCERN apostates; and prevent us from being "tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive." (Eph. 4:14)

Believers in Christ, we implore you to heed this clarion call: to remain true to the Faith and to speak thou the things which are sound doctrine!



The Apostolic Doctrine

I heard a song the other day and it went like this, "I am a one God, Apostolic, tongue talking, holy-rollin, born again, heaven bound believer in the liberating power of Jesus' Name. I have been washed in the blood, sanctified by the Spirit, I believe in holiness and suggest you do the same..."

I was intrigued to know what the writer meant by a One God, Apostolic, Tongue Talking, Born Again believer and Sanctified by the Spirit! So, I decided to investigate. I turned to a young minister for clarity; whose eyes lit up immediately and with a beaming smile began to explain.


"Well! This song sums up the Apostolic Doctrine". Taking one look at the blank expression on my face he went on to say, "the Apostolic doctrine is simply everything Jesus taught His Apostles concerning our salvation. They in turn taught it, preached it and sent it on a journey through time, until it reached us today. It is now so embedded in our hearts that we not only teach it and preach it, but we sing it rejoicing".

The Apostolic Doctrine (teaching) embodies: Monotheism; Faith Towards the One God; Confession; Repentance; Water Baptism in the Name of Jesus; Justification; Spirit Baptism; Sanctification and Living a Life that pleases God. Yet to be experienced are: the Rapture including Bodily Resurrection of the dead in Christ, Glorification and Eternal Life.

Monotheism is the Belief in One God, and His Name is Jesus; the one through whom God revealed himself to the world and reconciled man back to Himself (2 Cor. 5:19). This Jesus is the brightness

of God's glory, the express image of His person (Heb. 1:3), in whom dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily (Col. 2:9).

It's an absolute must that you be fully persuaded of who Jesus is; and whatever you do, in word or in deed, do all in His Name. The liberating power of Jesus Name renders all titles i.e. Father, Son and Holy Ghost powerless; because salvation (deliverance from sin) is not in a title or in any other name but in the Name of Jesus.



This then leads to **Confession and True Repentance:** confession being to agree with God that we are sinners in need of His salvation. So what then is True repentance? It is to be sorrowful for one's sins and make a firm decision to turn from sin and the World unto God. We can only secure God's forgiveness upon confession and true repentance: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us..." (1 John 1:9).

True repentance leads to **Water baptism**. Upon hearing the Gospel, the believers were pricked in their hearts and asked Peter, "What shall we do?" His reply was to repent and be baptised every one of you in the Name of Jesus for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:37 -38).

Water Baptism, as seen throughout the scriptures, is to be fully submerged in water. Jesus said to Nicodemus, "...except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God" (John 3:5).

To be **born of the Spirit** is simply to be filled with the Holy Spirit i.e. the Spirit of Christ takes up residence within you (Acts 2:4) and is evidenced by speaking in tongues. This is absolutely necessary for you to be made alive again in Christ, "And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins" (Eph. 2:1).

Sadly but true, we all died spiritually when Adam (the father of us all) sinned but thanks be to Jesus Christ

who died for our sins, washed and **Justified** us (to be declared righteous) by His blood (Rev. 1:5; Rom. 5:9; Heb. 9:26). Through water baptism we bury the 'old man and his deeds', and are made alive again through Spirit baptism. We can only be born again i.e. become a new creation in Christ through Water and Spirit baptism.

On Spirit Baptism we are fully immersed into the body of Christ; we receive His divine nature and character; and we are adopted as sons with full rights and privileges. As sons of God, we can enter into His presence without fear; enjoy intimacy with Christ and all the benefits of being a joint heir (Rom. 8:17).

As the song says, the born again believer is also "Sanctified by the Spirit..." The Holy Spirit is the agent of change of our character, behaviour, thinking and our lives: until we are transformed into the image of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit also gives us the power to overcome sin, temptations and the desires of the flesh.

The regenerated believer therefore, does not have to let sin dominate their thoughts, attitude, behaviour or will but willing submits to the loving influence of the Spirit. "... if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live" (Rom. 8:13).

The "heaven bound believer..." goes from glory to glory, living and enjoying a life that pleases God; as a bride adorned with holiness awaiting the return of Jesus her bridegroom.

And then at his coming i.e. **The Rapture** those who died 'in Christ' will be resurrected and those who are alive and remain in Him, will be caught out of the world to be with Him forevermore – an endless life.

n his book Apostolic History Outline, Rev Marvin and that He manifested Himself as Father in Creation, Arnold traces the spread of the Apostolic Faith from the birth of the Church at Jerusalem in AD33 up to the 20th Century. After John the Apostle died c. AD100, missionaries brought the Apostolic Faith to the UK as early as AD200 (Arnold, 1988).

This includes people such as 'Alban', after whom the town of St Alban's and the famed St Alban's cathedral is named. Alban was born again in the 3rd Century (AD200-299), in his day baptism was according to Acts 2:38 – 'In the name of Jesus Christ'. The Triune formula (i.e. repeating the words: 'in the Name of Father, Son and Holy Ghost') was not introduced until many years later during the 4th Century. Dr Arnold (1988) also identifies that there was a large number of Apostolic believers in areas such as Glastonbury. A stark contrast to today where Glastonbury is known for its rock festivals and witchcraft.

Contrary to popular belief the One God Apostolic Faith is not a branch of Catholicism; it existed long before the Roman Catholic Church was established. began at Pentecost with a few souls in the Upper Room and was preserved throughout the ages by men and women who continued steadfastly in the Apostles doctrine (Acts 2:42).

Tertullian (AD160-240), a key person in the development Trinitarian teaching, of the lamented the fact that the majority of Christians in the 3rd Century believed in One God who manifested Himself in three roles (Dünzl, 2007). This majority view was called 'Modalistic Monarchianism', because Christians believed in One Sovereign God (monarchy) Son in Redemption and Holy Spirit in the Church (i.e. Modal). The Monarchian Modalists were the successors of the Apostles, maintaining the faith once delivered to the Saints. Four Bishops of Rome have been identified by historians as being Modalistic Monarchians (i.e. One God Apostolic): Eleutherus (AD174 -189), Victor (AD189-199), Zephrinus (AD199-217), and Callistus (AD217-222).

In AD381, Trinitarian teaching became the official belief of the state sponsored Catholic (Universal) Church; which meant that the early One God Apostolics became enemies of the State and the Catholic Church . Notable One-God teachers such as Praxeas (c. AD150-189) and Sabellius (c. AD215) were retrospectively labelled heretics; although in their day they represented the biblical view held by most Christians. All that survives today are their

opponents' descriptions of them and their teachings. However, the haughty State could not stop the True Church. Jesus said: "I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Matt 16:18).

One of the first people to be killed in Europe for "heresy" by the Catholic Church was Pricillian, a Spanish Bishop, who taught Modalistic Monarchianism. He was executed in AD385 (Weisser, 1981); he was a virtuous man against whom many false charges were made. His blood was the first to be spilled and many believers were martyred in the years to come as the Catholic Church and her daughters (e.g. Protestant offshoots) fought to

uphold their Trinitarian doctrine.

For example, during the Spanish

Inquisition approx. 300,000

people were killed for not bowing to the Roman Catholic Church (Guardian, 2014). Amazingly, 300 years (AD693) after Pricillian's martyrdom, believers in the Oneness of God were still earnestly contending for the Faith that was once delivered to the Saints (Weisser, 1981).

In the 11th Century, God raised up Peter Abelard. In AD1121 at the Synod of Soisson the Roman Catholic Church condemned Peter's teaching on the Godhead as Sabellianism (Weisser, 1981). He taught that in 'Christ dwelt all the fullness of the Godhead bodily', and this teaching spread throughout Medieval Europe.

Similarly, in the 16th Century a Spaniard named Michael Servetus saw that the Trinity doctrine was unbiblical; and that it created a great barrier to converting monotheistic Jews and Moors (black Muslims). He wrote a book entitled: "On the Errors of the Trinity" in AD1531. He also sought to restore Europe back to the Apostolic Faith through his book, "The Restitution of Christianity" (Weisser, 1980).

Around the same time there was a large group of Apostolic believers known as Anabaptists. Anabaptist leader Sebastian Frank wrote in 1531, "The Roman Church postulates three Persons in one essence. I should rather agree with the Spaniard [Michael Servetus!" (Weisser, 1981, p.74). The early Anabaptists baptised in Jesus' Name, believed in the Oneness of God and were filled with the Spirit (Weisser, 1981; Bernard, 1996).

The Apostolic Church has survived through every age, and despite continual opposition the fire of Pentecost will never go out. In 1646 (17th Century) a Trinitarian writer Thomas Edwards wrote a book entitled: "Errors, Heresies and Blasphemies". Edwards included One God Apostolic believers in his list of heretics, and quoted their beliefs and practice, stating that: "The form by which men baptize, viz. 'I baptise thee in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost,' is a form of man's devising ... and that the baptism of Christ by water was only in the name of Jesus Christ, not of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost as is now practised."

William Booth-Chibborn (1893-1969) the grandson of William and Catherine Booth, founders of the Salvation Army, received the baptism of the Holy Ghost aged 15 in 1908. He was later baptised in Jesus Name

and became a One God preacher in the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World. Around this time there was a great restoration of the Apostolic Faith which has led to around 30 million Apostolic believers worldwide today (French, 2014).

Just like the writer to the Hebrews, time would not permit me to tell you of all the faithful One God Apostolic believers, who hazarded their lives throughout history to preserve this Faith. Those such as: Alvin Velie (1884-1904) who baptised over 1,500 people in Jesus name and wrote 'Safety First Acts 2:38' before the Azusa Street Revival of 1906; Bishop G.T. Havwood who in the 1930s led a global movement 250,000 members strong within 2,000 churches, three of which were in Palestine, four in Liberia and 10 in Jamaica; and Sydney Alexander Dunn whom with very little resources the Lord used to plant over 42 Apostolic Churches in the UK and worldwide from 1955-2016.

Apostolic believers, we have a goodly heritage! One that cannot be bought or sold; it is the Apostolic Faith! the faith of our fathers that is LIVING STILL in spite of dungeon, fire and sword.

Therefore, our only right and proper response to being entrusted with this like precious Faith, which has been handed down from Christ's Apostles to us today, (2 Pet. 1:1), is to remain TRUE to it unto death.
